- 1: Qe5+
  - 2: Qe5+      Rg7+
  - 3: e4+
  - 4: e5+
- Page 3:**
- 1: Qd8+
  - 2: Qd8+      Re8
  - 3: Re6+
  - 4: Bd3+
- Page 4:**
- 1: Nef7+
  - 2: Be4+
  - 3: Qc5
  - 4: Rf5+
- Page 5:**
- 1: b6      (Pawns hold until King comes over to assist)
  - 2: No. Then it is a draw. Black should try something else and win.
  - 3: Ba5      (Pawns cannot move)
  - 4: Nd3+      then Ne5 forking Rook and Queen
