










1: White to move



2: Black to move (same position as #1)




3: White to move, (Time to simplify for an easy win)




4: White to move (from an actual tournament game played)







1: White to move



2: White to move, (This is a 2-step problem)




3: White to move (this is a 2-step problem)

Answers for Chess Puzzles

Page 2: 1: 0-0-0+

2: Qe4+ and mate soon

3: Re7 (forces Rook exchange and easy King/Rook ending)

4: Bf6

Page 3: 1: RxN(6)

2: Bf8 and then Bd5

3: Rg8+, King moves. check King AGAIN with other rook, capture Queen

4: g4 Bg6 f5

Page 4: 1: Qe6+ Kh8 Nf7+ Kh8 Nh6++ Kh8 Qg8+ RxQ Nf7 # (amazing !!)
